Course Description

The Course in Asbestos Awareness 10675NAT provides learners with knowledge of the hazards and risks associated with asbestos exposure and inhalation. Learners will gain the necessary knowledge and skills to determine when and where asbestos and Asbestos Containing Material (ACM) may be present, the precautions that need to be taken if it is present and reporting procedures.

The course also involves understanding each individual's general duty of care to ensure the health, safety and welfare of all workers, visitors, contractors and others in the workplace.

Course Outcomes

Upon successful completion of this course, the learner will receive a Statement of Attainment in ASBIRA001A Identify and report asbestos containing materials.

Successful completion of this course will allow participants to meet WorkSafe ACT requirements specified in Section 19 (3) (f) of the ACT Work Health and Safety Act 2011 in addition to meeting the WorkSafe ACT Guidance Note for "Workers who may encounter asbestos in their work must be trained".

Course Assessments

Competency is obtained through a theory assessment. The theory assessment will be undertaken in a written form.

If you feel you will be disadvantaged by undertaking a written assessment, please discuss with your trainer/assessor prior to beginning the theory assessment.

Admission

All attendees must have a USI (Unique Student Identifier). We are unable to issue a credential unless a valid USI has been provided.

You will need to apply for a USI prior to the course or be prepared to apply for one on the day (in which case a Driving License and Medicare Card is required).
